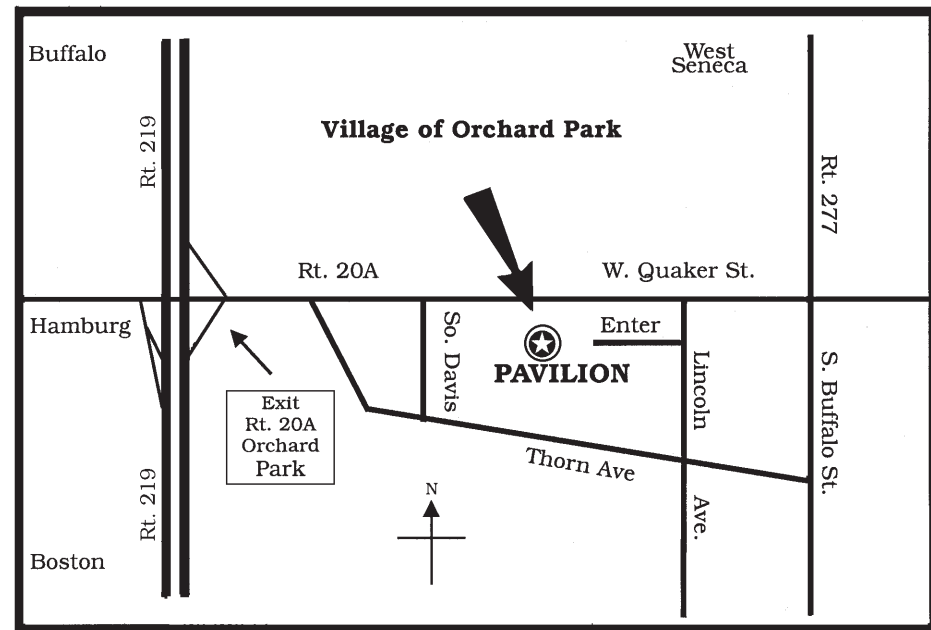

There is parking at the Middle School, on the side streets around the Pavilion, and behind the Municipal Building on South Buffalo Street, 1 block away. *Because the Pavilion is on school property, smoking and alcoholic beverages are not permitted.* It IS O.K., however, to go to the concessions stand during the concert!

Access for persons with disabilities is by way of the driveway that runs along the North side of the Pavilion.
